
Here is an example where the verbs are encourage, empower, and enable, and the value is integrity. Integrity in the sense of an integrated life.



Refining your Ikiverse

Use distinction work to refine and enrich your verse.

Distinction work involves exploring the deeper meaning of words by examining their definitions, synonyms, and roots.

This process consists of delving into the nuances of language to understand the subtle differences between similar words better and identify the underlying concepts and ideas that a particular word represents.

By understanding the origin and history of a word, and its various connotations and associations, one can gain a deeper appreciation of the richness and complexity of the word.

Ultimately, distinction work allows one to unlock the full potential of language and to use it as a powerful tool to create your lkiverse.
